CARGO ARRIVAL INSTRUCTIONS

Sea Freight Shipments:

- Seaport of Discharge: Jebel Ali Seaport only.
- > Original shipping documents must be couriered to our office **5 working days** prior to shipment arrival.
- Shipments arriving either by FCL or LCL should arrive in Jebel Ali seaport **10 working days** before the exhibition.

Air Freight Shipments:

- > Airport of Discharge: Abu Dhabi Airport.
- Original shipping documents must be attached to the AWB pouch or couriered to our office in advance prior to shipment arrival.
- Shipments should arrive in Abu Dhabi Airport 8 working days before the exhibition.

Road Freight Shipments:

- > Port of Discharge: Al Guwaifat Border, Silaa Abu Dhabi only.
- > Trucks/Shipments should arrive at the UAE border at least **6 working days** before the exhibition.

Failure to comply with the arrival deadlines may result in non-delivery, late arrivals, and additional surcharges which Schenker LLC cannot be held responsible for. At the same time, any port storage and demurrage incurred because of this shall be additional to the account of the freight agent/exhibitor.

Cargo arriving after the deadlines dates as mentioned above will be subject to a 30% late arrival surcharge on the basic handling tariff.

Copy of the Courier waybill and commercial invoice should be sent to Schenker for checking prior to the shipment's departure. Shipment will be transferred to the Venue during the show build-up.

Please note that Schenker will have no control over the customs clearance of courier shipments. If the value of goods exceeds USD 250.00 or required Special permissions from the ministry, some of courier companies are not clearing the cargo as courier shipment. We can take over the customs clearance, but we need 3 to 4 working days for the cargo without any special ministry permissions. Complete shipment details must be stated in the commercial invoice and packing list. Charges applicable will be based on the Airfreight Tariff.

Courier Shipment directly to show site

Sending Courier shipments directly to show site is not advisable. Some courier companies will allow anyone within the venue to sign for the Shipment (ie, cleaner, visitor, car park attendant) and the shipment may not make its way to your stand with no possibility to locate it within the venue. For that reason, Schenker will not be responsible for courier shipments until received at our on-site office regardless of whether they are addressed to us or not.

It is the exhibitor's responsibility to check with Schenker to see if their packages have been received. Schenker will not notify the exhibitor that their goods have arrived.

Courier shipments arriving directly at the show site requiring payment of UAE customs duty or any freight charges will be refused by the Schenker unless pre-arranged. Shipments **MUST** therefore be sent on a **Delivered Duty Paid (DDP)** basis.

Commercial Invoice/Packing List (CIPL):

The CIPL must be in English and printed on Shippers Original Company Letter Head embossed with original wet rubber stamped and authorized signature. Color printouts and/or photocopy of CIPL formats are not acceptable.

The CIPL must be itemized, clearly detailing each item of your shipment specifying the description, serial number if any, country of origin along with the individual unit value, total value, and weight of each item.

The CIPL must clearly mention the Total Number of Packages, Total Gross Weight, Total Value of the Goods. The packing details must tally the details mentioned on the waybills.

Goods under Permanent Import such us giveaways, brochures, consumables, gift items, etc. must be marked on CIPL remarks column detailing all the information as mentioned above. The packages must be physically packed separately. This is a must to ensure accurate calculation of Customs Duty and Import VAT at the time of re- export.

The CIPL must contain the below declaration: "We hereby guarantee that this is a true and correct invoice, and that the goods referred to are the origin, manufacture, and production of (Indicate the Country of Origin)." As an addendum to your CIPL, you should declare all names and addresses of companies responsible for the manufacture of items within you Shipment.

Certificate of Origin:

This Document must be sent in Original issued and attested by the Chamber of Commerce at origin only.

Waybills:

Shipments arriving to **Abu Dhabi Airport/Seaport** must be consigned to **Schenker Logistics LLC**, Al Salman Tower, Hamdan Street, Abu Dhabi, UAE.

Shipments arriving to **Dubai Airport/ Jebel Ali Seaport** must be consigned to **Schenker LLC c/o JWS 2023**, PO Box 62532, Dubai, UAE.

Failing which we will not be able to process customs clearance. Separate House Airway bills (HAWB) or Forwarders Bill of Ladings (FBL) must be issued for individual Exhibitors per Shipment stating the correct shipment details.

HS Code Summary:

HS Code Summary must clearly mention the HS Codes related to the actual items being shipped. In case of multiple HS Codes, you will also need to provide us with the HS Code Summary sheet clearly mentioning the individual country of origin, weight, and value per HS Code applicable for each shipment.



ATA Carnet:

The United Arab Emirates is now a member of the ATA Carnet Consortium. Dubai Customs implemented the facility for customs clearance under ATA Carnet, which is strictly subjected to Dubai Customs Rules and Regulations. Exhibitors or the overseas forwarders are requested to contact us in advance for assistance and must obtain our approval before dispatch of any shipment under ATA Carnet. Dubai Customs terms and conditions would apply. *Please check with us before carrying out the shipment under ATA Carnet.*

Rules & Regulations for ATA Carnet

ATA Carnet clearance in Dubai is governed by very strict custom's rules and regulations. Please adhere to the following:

- 1. Indicate ATA Carnet Reference Number on the Waybills.
- 2. Only one (1) ATA Carnet is allowed per shipment; multiple ATA Carnet will not be entertained.
- **3.** Number of packages, package type, weight etc. mentioned on the ATA Carnet must besame in the shipping documents. (i.e., Waybill details must match with the ATACarnet declared information). Also, Country of Origin must be indicated in the ATA Carnet.
- 4. Make sure that the weight and number of packages indicated on the ATA Carnet is accurate as the same weight and number of packages should be re-exported. Please note that re-export shipment will be weighed at the Airport and if a different weight ismonitored, shipment may be detained by the Customs. Complete shipment (100%) must be re-exported!
- 5. Permanent import items like consumable, giveaways and brochures must not be included or clubbed with ATA Carnet shipment. Such items must be sent as separate shipment on Commercial Invoice and Packing List.
- 6. Shipment on ATA Carnet cannot be re-exported or returned partially or as multiple shipments.
- 7. 'Any Authorized Representative' must be mentioned in the "Represented By" Column on the ATA Carnet.
- 8. An original Authorization Letter authorizing "Schenker LLC" to handle the ATA Carnet on behalf of the Exhibitor is mandatory. The ATA Carnet Reference Number must be indicated, and letter must be printed on the ATA Carnet holder headed paper with original stamp and representative signature.
- 9. Please indicate "Fairs & Exhibitions" in the Purpose column of the ATA Carnet.

<u>For Land Freight Shipments</u>, all the items being shipped must have serial numbers clearly embossed on each item/piece and the same must also reflect in the CIPL. If the serial numbers are not properly embossed or differ to the declaration, customs may not accept these markings in which case customs duties will apply. <u>Importation basis</u> Temporary import of goods arriving via Land freight is totally up to the discretion of Border customs

Failing to provide us with Original Documents fulfilling the above requirements in detail will invite Customs Fines, Excess Duty Assessment, and delays with Customs Clearance. Hence, making it difficult and at times not possible for customs clearance.

<u>Any Customs Fines and Excess Duty Assessments – caused due to incorrect / improper / missing documents will</u> be billed to the respective Freight Agent/Client

For All Shipments

The Original Shipping documents as specified above must be sent to Schenker LLC, in Dubai at least 5 working days prior to the arrival of the vessel if sent by sea freight or attached to the Original Airway Bill pouch if the goods are sent by airfreight

A Full Pre-advice of dispatch should be sent to Schenker LLC in Dubai much in advance prior to the arrival of the freight providing all shipping details along with a copy of the shipping documents.

RESTRICTED CARGO

The following documents are required for the temporary import clearance of goods Ex-Arrival Dubai.

UAE customs do not permit import of some commodities such as Alcohol or Pork and products containing alcohol or pork or any of its byproducts which are strictly restricted for import into the UAE.

Importation of products such as food items, live plants/flowers, tiles/marbles, wireless/radio, telecommunication / defense equipment and radioactive materials of hazardous nature, Cosmetics, Class rated cargo, etc. are very restricted for import into UAE.

However, these goods can be imported after obtaining prior approvals and special permissions from the respective ministry authorities.

To enable us to arrange for such import permissions, we suggest you send us complete details and information of such items at least 45 to 50 days in advance prior to the shipping. Import permissions are solely subject to approvals from the respective ministry and must be shipped only after receipt of these import permits.

<u>MOH PERMISSION</u> For Medical Equipment, Health related Materials, required ISO/EC certificates Undertaking letter / Authorization letter / MOH forms, and Catalogues are required.

Charges applicable to secure these permissions will be additional on the account of the exhibitor/Agent in addition to our processing fees of USD 125.00 per permission. However, fees for the Permission from Ministry of Health is on Minimum USD 310.00/- Or actual as advised by the government authority.

Original documents for permission related shipments must receive in original at least 10 days before arrival to avoid delay of completing the process by the authority

Importation of exhibits such as weapons, ammunition, explosives, or any other military equipment is strictly restricted for import into the UAE. If you intend to ship any such items, please contact Schenker LLC well in advance at least 4 months prior to the actual shipping of the goods. Note the goods must NOT be shipped until you receive a confirmation to proceed from Schenker LLC.

PACKAGE / CASE MARKINGS

The following documents are required for the temporary import clearance of goods Ex-Arrival Dubai.

CUSTOMS DUTY & IMPORT VAT

The "Port & Custom Authorities" of Dubai levy a 5% Customs Duty on goods, which are sold/consumed/destroyed and not re-exported at the end of the show based on the Cost, Insurance, Freight (C.I.F.) value of the goods or as assessed by Dubai Customs.

All Customs Duty assessments are solely up to the discretion by UAE Customs. UAE customs can re-evaluate the value declared on the invoices and the duty is calculated and outlaid as assessed by the UAE customs.

Before the close of the show, Schenker LLC representatives will be on -site during the show to help exhibitors with the re-export, disposal, or giveaways. In the event if the exhibitor would like to dispose/sell his goods during the exhibition, the permanent importation of these items can be process subject to approval from the Dubai Customs. However, Customs Duty will be applicable on these items.

All customs duty (Part or Full Duty) applicable towards shipments being sent to Dubai will be bill to the respective freight agent or client as assessed by Dubai Customs. An Outlay fee of 3 % of the customs duty will be charged additionally towards this service.

The Federal Tax Authority Charges Import VAT on all goods imported in the UAE along Value Added Tax (VAT) for all local services.

Import VAT is computed based on 5% of the total CIF Value + 5% of the Outlaid Customs Duty which will be refunded if the cargo will be re-exported. If cargo will be consumed, given-away and/or sold during the exhibition, Import VAT will be applicable along with Import VAT Service Fee of USD 45.00 + 5% VAT.

VAT for local services is computed based on 5% of any local services rendered.

CARGO INSURANCE

You are strongly recommended to check with your All Risk Insurer that you are fully covered for all the work we may undertake on your behalf and to advise them of our conditions.

As our Tariff is computed based on shipment volume and weight and has no correlation with the Value of the exhibits, it follows that the cost of insurance cover is not included in our charges. It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to arrange a Full Marine (Transport) Insurance covering transport of your goods from your domicile to the exhibition, and the return of the same back to your domicile at the end of the show, including the period your exhibits/goods are handled by us. Please also ensure that the Marine (Transport) Insurance is arranged for the exhibits/goods sold locally during the exhibition.

Schenker LLC will not accept any liability towards any loss or damage of your exhibits/goods.

SPECIAL HANDLING

For any Box or Crate, which exceeds more than 2 tons a piece or with dimensions that exceed 2m x 2m x 1.5m where special handling is required, we will quote our handling charges on a case-to-case basis. For manpower or equipment, which may be required to assist exhibitors, additional cost will be quoted on request.

PAYMENT TERMS
